BURSARY SCHEME

A. Objectives

The Brighton Bursary Scheme provides financial assistance to needy students in Government or Private Institutions (i.e. Primary and Secondary Schools, Junior Colleges, Polytechnics, ITE and Universities).

B. Who can apply for this scheme?

1. Applicants must be:
 - a. Children attending Brighton Kidz or youths/young adults attending Brighton Community Church, and
 - b. Full-time students in Government or Private Institutions.

C. How to apply for this scheme?

1. The scheme is open for application from **July**. The application form is available via the church website at <https://www.brighton.org.sg/bursary>.
2. Applicants should submit the following documents by **30 September**:
 - a. Completed application form
 - b. A copy of the applicant's student card
 - c. A most recent copy of the family member(s)' pay slip/ income statement/ CPF contribution
3. The Brighton Bursary Committee reserves the right to approve or reject an application in its sole and absolute discretion without assigning any reason whatsoever.
4. Successful applicants will be notified in writing by end **November**.

D. What is the quantum of assistance for successful applicants?

1. The quantum of assistance will be tiered by the educational level of the applicant for the period of one year:

Primary school : Up to \$600

Secondary school/JC : Up to \$1200

Polytechnic/ITE : Up to \$1800

University : Up to \$2400

2. The bursaries will be disbursed on the **third week** of every month, via PayNow/Bank transfer for a period of 12 months. Disbursement will commence in **January**.
3. All successful applicants are required to go through a 6-monthly follow-up with their respective Zone Leaders on their financial situation after receiving the bursaries. The tentative follow-up date is **1 July of the year of Bursary scheme**.
4. The Brighton Bursary Committee has the right to reduce, withdraw, suspend or terminate all forms of assistance and for such period as it deems fit or necessary.

E. What if I want to apply for this bursary but don't fit the above criteria?

Bursaries may still be given out, even if the applicant does not fully meet the eligibility criteria stated above. However, such deviations will only be made on a strictly case-by-case basis and upon the Zone leader's recommendation.
